SUMMARY

The Irrigation Service Technician is an employee of All-n-One who is responsible for the maintenance and repair of commercial and residential irrigation systems, low voltage outdoor lighting and pet containment systems. This person ensures services are rendered timely and works with other employees within the company on any other services provided by All-n-One. This team member completes work according to a schedule where maintenance and installation of services are being performed. This person works directly with the Irrigation Service Manager and other team members within the Irrigation Division to establish a best model plan to deliver exceptional quality to the customer. The team member participates in meetings, training sessions, and demonstrates the All-n-One Pledge of Excellence.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Embrace the company mission, work as hard as you can to help achieve our vision statement and live your life according to our core values
- Troubleshoot and repair irrigation pipe and fittings, sprinkler heads
- Troubleshoot and repair electrical components related to irrigation and low voltage lighting
- Perform general and seasonal system maintenance
- Installs, repairs and test backflow prevention device
- Locate and repair malfunctioning equipment
- Be proactive with diagnosing and repairing irrigation systems
- Troubleshoot and repair outdoor lighting
- Troubleshoot and repair pet containment systems
- Complete daily work orders as required by each job
- Work independently and in teams in order to meet deadlines
- Work to become knowledgeable in ALL aspects of the business including but not limited to: lawn maintenance, irrigation, outdoor lighting, fertilization, lawn care, pet containment, and any other services provided by All-n-One
- Analyze property and system needs and provide recommendations for improvements to staff and/or customers
- Obtain any certification that may be required
- Use a smartphone or tablet to accurately report hours worked by job each day
- Become a servant leader
- Perform all other duties as required and assigned

- Backflow Certified a plus, but not required
- Attention to detail
- Ability to perform time reporting functions on a smartphone and/or tablet
- Ability to communicate effectively with managers and customers
- Ability to pass a background check
- Ability to pass government employee verification; E-Verify
- Possess a current and clean driver's license, but be over 21
- Ability to safely operate a motor vehicle while pulling a trailer
- 1+ years' experience in irrigation maintenance, repair and installation

WORKING CONDITIONS

- Work is typically performed outdoors
- Must be able to work in all types of weather conditions
- May be required to drive to/from job sites while pulling a trailer any time of day

- Ability to work long hours
- Physical strength requiring upper body forces up to 50 lbs. Lifting up to 75 lbs; transfer vertical items up to 100 lbs.

- Ability to drive and travel via vehicle for long periods of time
