



## **Job Position – Landscape Maintenance Technician**

### **SUMMARY**

The Landscape Maintenance Technician is an employee of All-n-One whose primary responsibility is to help plant and maintain seasonal color while providing flower bed maintenance for our residential and commercial clients. Daily tasks include weeding, fertilizing, pruning, watering and mulching of landscapes. This person will ensure plants and landscapes are well taken care of to the expectations and guidelines from the Business Operations Leader. Assisting other departments will be done as necessary. The Landscape Maintenance Technician participates in meetings and training sessions and demonstrates the All-n-One Pledge of Excellence.
